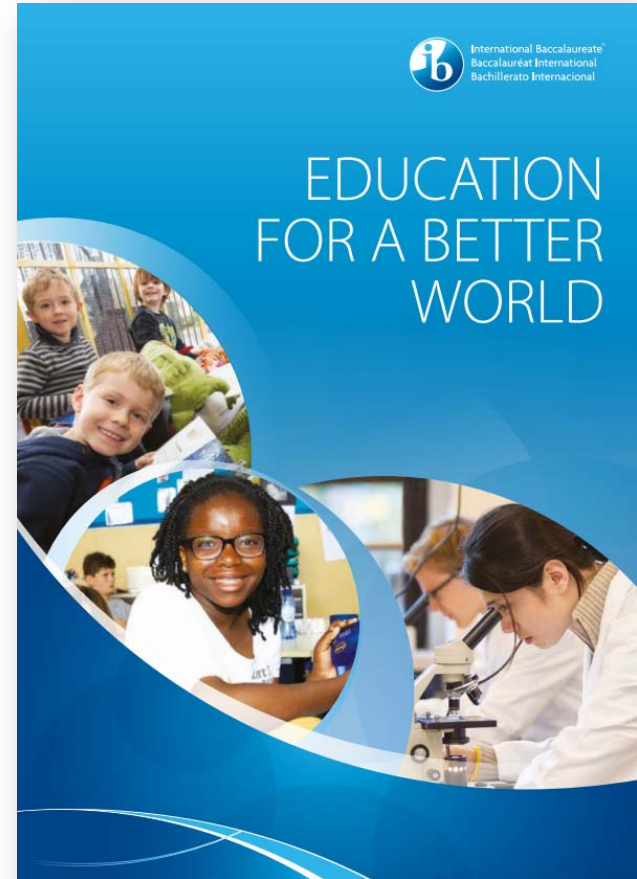
What is an IB Education?

IB learner profile

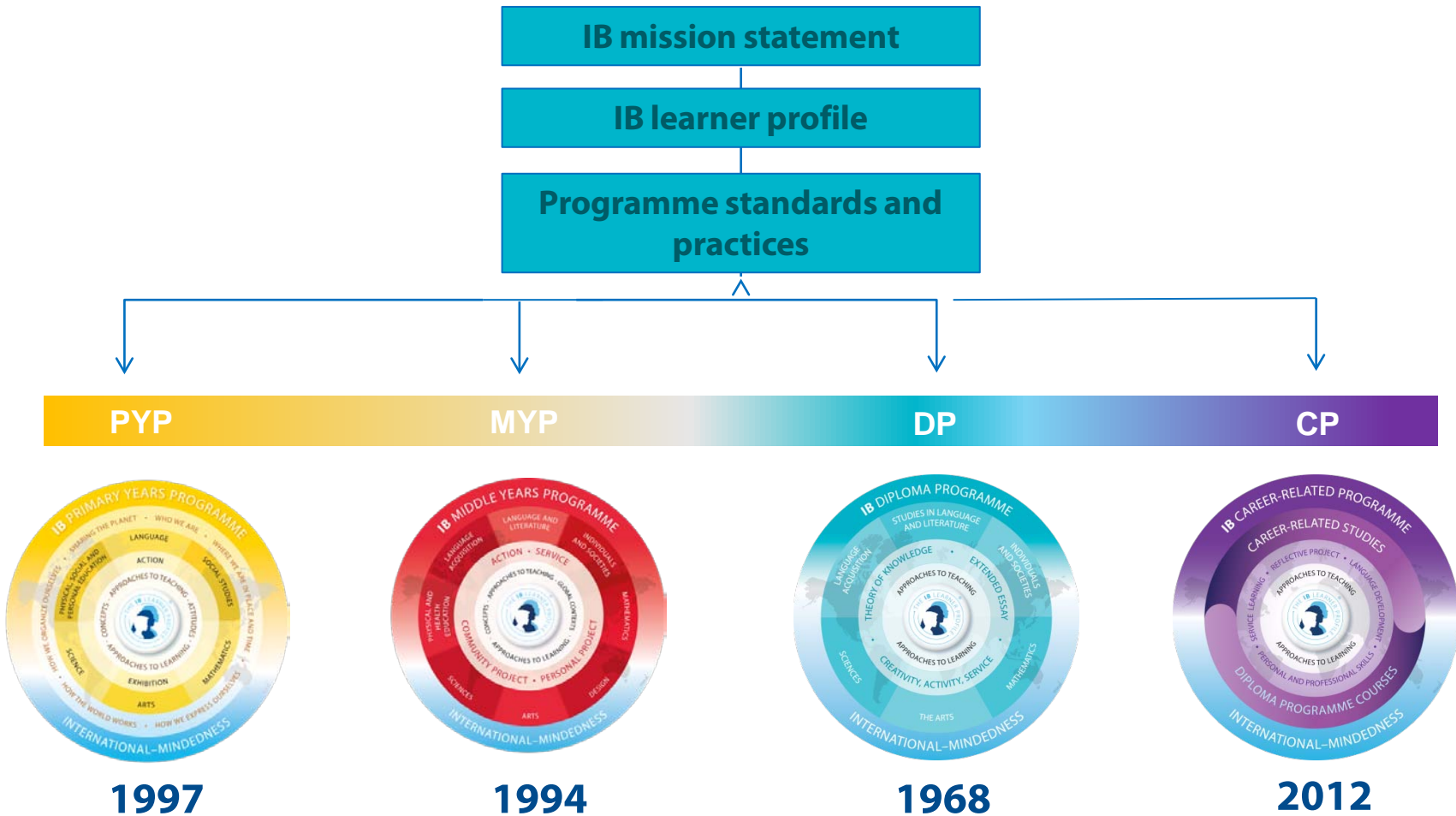
- The IB learner profile is the IB mission statement translated into a set of learning outcomes for the 21st century

 - reflective



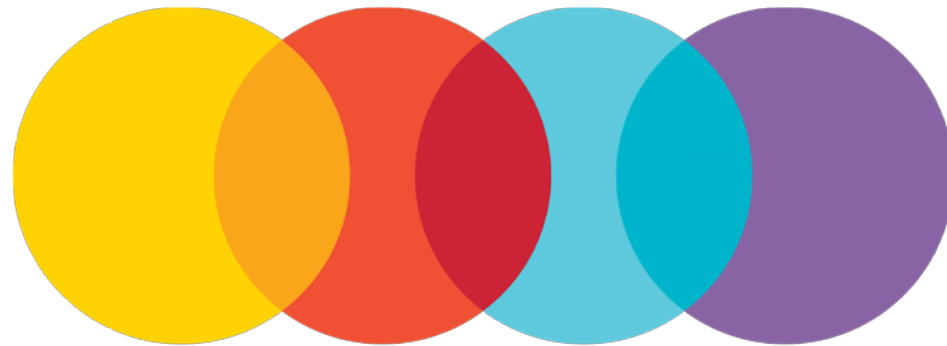
The Continuum graphic
